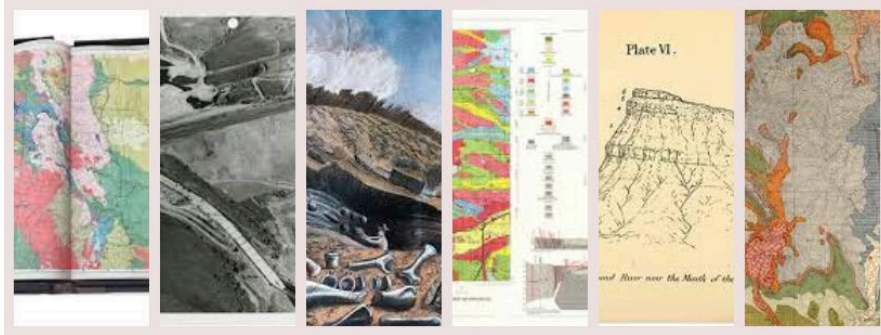


CU Map Library Field Trip: May 20, 2023 10:30 AM - 12 Noon



Our next field trip takes us to the CU Map Library on the Boulder campus, where Colorado Mineral Society (CMS) members will join us on a private tour. We'll learn about CU's amazing collections and get hands-on advice on how to conduct research with their holdings (over 200,000 maps, atlases, drawings).

The Map Library holds a wealth of resources including historical maps, old mine maps, aerial images, atlases, topography illustrations, and geological maps and images. The Map Library is an official USGS repository and holds all USGS maps.

Our hosts have kindly offered to bring out maps and material for our visit. We'll see Hayden maps. Artur Lakes illustrations (bone wars, etc.), old wall maps of Boulder mines, maps and drawings of the Marshall coal fields, and plenty more.

It should be a fun trip and it will be great to host our friends from CMS. Please know that we have a rather limited capacity of only 18 participants for our FMC members, so sign up soon!
