June 10 FMC "Double Header" Field Trip:

Phoenix Gold Mine AND Argo Mill & Tunnel, Idaho Springs, CO

Idaho Springs beckons us for a June 10th "double-header" field trip to Idaho Springs, where we will visit both the Phoenix Gold Mine AND the "Mighty" Argo Mill & Tunnel. The combination gets us into a legendary hard rock gold mine (Phoenix), and a monumental mill for processing gold (Argo Mill & Tunnel). This trip includes gold panning at both locations, and Argo will even seed your pan with a flake of gold. Each tour is a little over an hour.

This is a classic field trip that covers gold mining, ore processing, mining equipment (Argo has a great static display), history, and gold panning.
